MUSE SB meeting

- INFN Pisa researchers are working on a new version of their waveform digitizer board, developed for the Mu2e Calorimeter Readout.
 - The new version goes in the direction of a common use with the MUSE industrial partner CAEN. For the purpose it was introduced a new Gbit ethernet port that allows to connect the digitizer to commercial workstations.
 - The new digitizer design will be finalized together by INFN Pisa researchers and a Prisma engineer, that is supposed to be seconded in Pisa in the next months. This will allow Prisma to gain experience in designing radiation tolerant electronic boards.

The INFN Pisa group has organized a full week training course regarding the transfer of knowledge between public research institutions and private companies. Part of the course was also related to European Projects development in the H2020 with few hints toward the new FP9.
